# Downtown Synagogue Offers Free Grooming Services to Detroit's Seniors, Veterans & Disadvantaged

Detroit, MI, December 5, 2016 – The Isaac Agree Downtown Synagogue (Downtown Synagogue), the Urban Bean Company (Urban Bean), and other businesses and faith-based organizations with ties to Detroit's re-emerging Capitol Park District will provide complementary haircuts to seniors, veterans, and those who are economically disadvantaged. The event, titled "Grooming on Griswold," will take place 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. on Monday, December 19 at the Downtown Synagogue, 1457 Griswold in Detroit. This is the second time the function has been held since 2014.

"For most of us, a haircut is something so simple we hardly think about it – but giving one to somebody who otherwise couldn't afford it can be tremendously meaningful," said Josh Greenwood, owner of the Urban Bean and one of the program organizers. "It's something that can lift spirits and restore dignity. It's not just about cutting hair – it's about touching hearts. Those of us involved are grateful we can offer this gift during the holiday season."

"Grooming on Griswold" coordinators have reached out to local shelters, clinics, soup kitchens, and houses of worship to spread the word about the opportunity for a complementary haircut for both men and women. The Downtown Synagogue will be furnished with styling chairs and hair basins to provide individuals with washes and trims. Hand massages and manicures will be offered, as well. No appointment is needed.
